## CCHA COVID-19 Alert

### **Governor Announces \$60 Million in COVID-19 Primary Care Vaccination Grants**

*Primary care practices can apply immediately for funds to support expanding access to the COVID-19 vaccine*

Yesterday, Governor Polis announced a new grant program for primary care providers (PCPs). Funded by Colorado Department of Public Health (CDPHE) and administered by the Colorado Health Institute (CHI), the [COVID-19 Primary Care Vaccination Program](#) aims to increase engagement and enrollment of PCPs in Colorado's COVID-19 vaccination program by providing financial support to community-based organizations and health care service providers.

Approximately \$60 million is available for approximately 665 PCP practice locations. To be eligible for funding, practices must also be either enrolled or applying to [enroll with CDPHE as a COVID-19 vaccine provider](#).

**Applications are being accepted now and will be reviewed on a rolling first come, first-served basis until all available funds are disbursed.** Applications close December 1, 2021. Early submission is encouraged!
